President Tim Phillips moved that Evelyn be given emeritus status for her tremendous contributions to the LMWCC over the years.

The motion passed unanimously.

There will be an election of trustees. Jim Squier, Dan Sernick, Steve Bishop, Joyce Durdel, Armas Soorus, Joe Rogers and David Spruance are all eligible for re-election to two-year terms.

Josh Shields, forester with the Manistee Conservation District will be the speaker at the annual members' meeting.

Dan Sernick made a motion that LMWCC contribute \$1000.00 to the DNR program to re-introduce grayling into historical grayling streams in northern Michigan including the Manistee River system. After a short yet heated debate the motion carried by a 7-3 margin.
