- Watershed Management Plan
  - Ed has made almost all of the changes requested by EGLE and has formatted the entire document as requested. We are in the final stages of reviewing the full document and expect to have the final maps to merge in next week.
  - Armas hopes to submit it next week (week of April 6<sup>th</sup>) but it is probably going to be another week or two to get the maps and merge them in.
  - The annual watershed summit was held on March 6. There were 16 in attendance and completed the Task Review for the final group of items on the list. Armas will be emailing out minutes soon.
- 2020 Watershed volunteer meeting scheduled for April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 was cancelled.
- Monitoring Station update
  - Armas has been continuing work on the first monitoring station. He has the radios and internet connection hardware as well as the sensor. He is about to connect the sensor and have a trial run with the software. At that point at a minimum we will be able to log data to a microSD card and he will do the final work with the radio and internet connection.
